
**SECRETARY'S CERTIFICATE**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2012-2**

**ORDINANCE NO. 2018-2 ADOPTING THE PREVAILING WAGE RATES  
FOR LABORERS, WORKERS AND MECHANICS  
EMPLOYED BY THE ROSELLE PUBLIC LIBRARY DISTRICT**

**WHEREAS**, the State of Illinois has enacted "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, (820 ILCS 130/1-12); and

**WHEREAS**, the aforesaid Act requires that the Roselle Library District investigate and ascertain the prevailing rate of wages as defined in said Act for laborers, mechanics and other workers in the locality of said Library District employed in performing construction of public works for said Library District.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDAINED** by the Board of Library Trustees of the Roselle Public Library District, DuPage and Cook Counties, Illinois:

**Section 1:** To the extent and as required by "An ACT regulating wages of laborers, mechanics and other workers employed in any public works by the State, county, city or any public body or any political subdivision or by anyone under contract for public works," approved June 26, 1941, as amended, the general prevailing rate of wages in this locality for laborers, mechanics and other workers engaged in the construction of public works coming under the jurisdiction of this Library District is hereby ascertained to be the same as the prevailing rate of wages for construction work in the DuPage County area as determined by the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois, as of June 2018, a copy of that determination being attached hereto as Exhibit "A" and is incorporated herein by reference. The definition of any terms appearing in this Ordinance which are also used in the aforesaid Act shall be the same as in said Act.

**Section 2:** Nothing herein contained shall be construed to apply said general prevailing rate of wages as herein ascertained to any work or employment except public works construction of this Library District to the extent required by the aforesaid Act.

**Section 3:** The Secretary shall publicly post or keep available for inspection by any interested party in the main office of this Library District this determination of such prevailing rate of wage.

**Section 4:** The Secretary shall mail a copy of this determination to any employer, and to any association of employers and to any person or association of employees who have filed, or file their name and addresses, requesting copies of any determination stating the particular rates and the particular class of workers whose wages will be affected by such rates.

**Section 5:** The Secretary shall promptly file a certified copy of this Ordinance with both the Secretary of State and the Department of Labor of the State of Illinois.

**Section 6:** The Secretary shall cause a notice to be published on the Library District's website that the determination of prevailing wages has been made. Said notice shall include a hyperlink to the Illinois Department of Labor's wage chart for the County of DuPage. Such publication shall constitute notice that this is the determination of the Roselle Library District and is effective.
